For users who plan to access and run applications on LearningPoint, download and install the **LearningPoint Client**.


Download and Installation Tips:

Installation Instructions

- From the download page, choose to download the LearningPoint Client
- In the File Download window, choose to “Run” the LPClient.msi file.
- Installation should happen automatically and you will then be able to run My.Desktop.
- If your computer has an older version of the installer software, you may get an error when your attempt to run the LPClient.msi file.

Installation Instructions continued

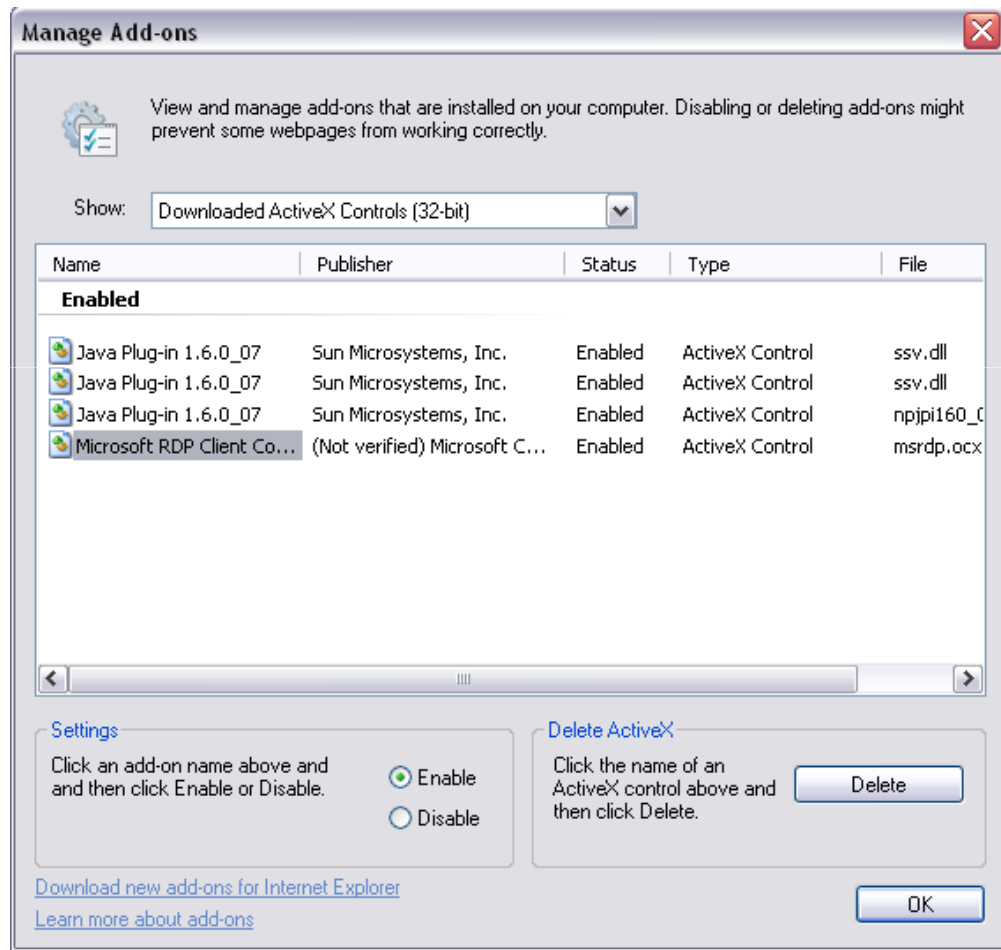
- If you do encounter an error, choose to download the LearningPoint Client again from the download page.
- This time in the File Download window, choose to “Save” the file. You can save this to any folder, or even your desktop. Just remember where you put it.
- Using My Computer on your desktop, locate the file and double click on it to run it.

Windows XP with IE7 users

- After running the file, you need to check that the file is enabled.
- Launch Internet Explorer and Choose the Tools/Manage Add-ons/Enable Add-ons



Windows XP with IE7 users

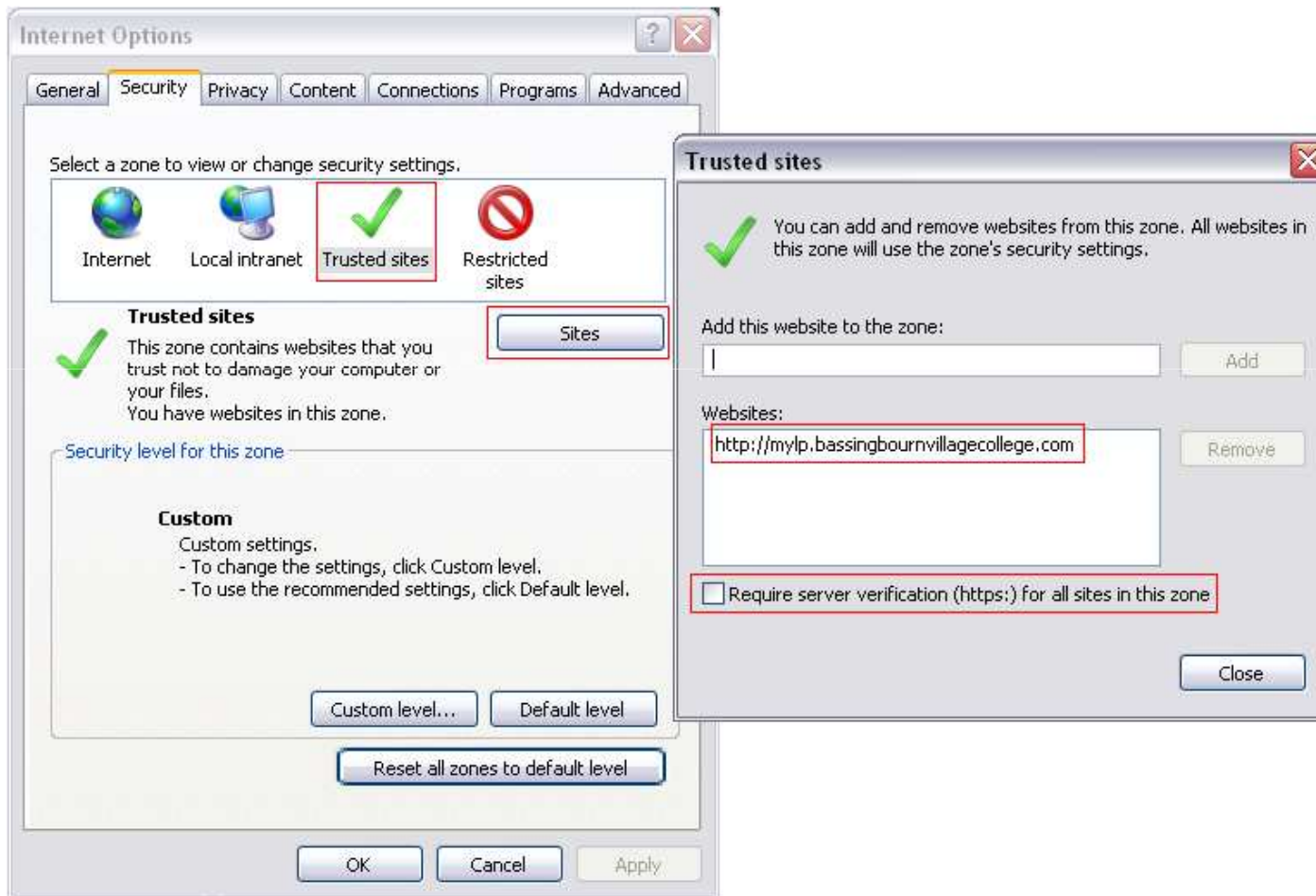


- Confirm that the “Show” box says “Downloaded ActiveX Controls”
- Confirm that the Microsoft RDP Client says “Enabled” under Status.
- If it says “disabled”, click on it and choose “Enable” from the settings box in the bottom left corner.

Windows Vista with IE7 users

- Open Internet Explorer, go to 'Tools' > 'Internet Options' > 'Security tab' > 'Trusted Sites' > Click on the 'Sites' button
- Confirm that it says 'http://mylp.bassingbournvillagecollege.com' in the top text box
- Confirm that 'Require server verification (https)...' is unticked > click 'Add' > click 'Close' > click 'Okay' to exit.
